

Our Commitment to Safeguarding

Under the Education Act 2002, we must make arrangements to safeguard and promote the welfare of children. The Children Act 1989 requires all staff to pass on information which gives rise to a concern about a child's welfare.

Staff will, in general, discuss any concerns with you, and the need to make a referral to Children's Social Care if considered necessary. This will only be done where such discussion will not place the child at increased risk of significant harm or cause undue delay. We will seek advice from Children's Social Care when we have reasonable cause to suspect a child may be suffering or likely to suffer significant harm.

Occasionally, concerns are passed on which are later found to be unfounded. Please appreciate that our Designated Safeguarding Leads carry out their responsibilities in accordance with the law and act in the best interests of all children.

If you have any concerns regarding the safety or welfare of any child, please contact our **Designated Safeguarding Leads**, (Nerys or Julie) in confidence.

2-Year-old funded sessions (2HELP)

Up to 15 hours of FREE childcare available per week for eligible families, for 38 weeks per year.

- We provide **Morrison's Nutmeg Factor 50 sun cream**. We are no longer using Nivea Factor 50 sun cream; the ingredients have recently changed to include almond oil, which may be harmful to children with nut allergies.

If you have previously given consent for us to apply sun cream, we will assume you are happy with the alternative brand unless you advise us to the contrary.

We spend a lot of time outside, exploring with water, mud, sand and lots of other messy things, so we suggest that your child does not wear their best clothes to nursery!
