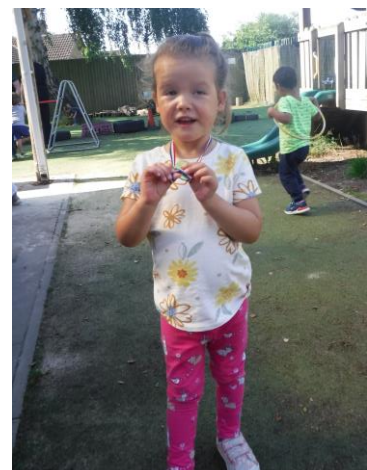
Our Educational Programme: Understanding the World
