

Welcome back!

We are delighted to be welcoming all children back to nursery from 1st July. The children who returned in June have settled very well. To continue to ensure safety, we ask you to:-

- NOT bring your child to nursery, if your child, or someone in your household has coronavirus symptoms.
- NOT bring your child to nursery if you have been contacted by the NHS track and trace service and your child has been told to self-isolate for 14 days.
- Be available to collect your child immediately if they develop coronavirus symptoms while at nursery.
- [Request a test](#) for your child if they display symptoms of coronavirus and notify us immediately of a positive test. A positive test will ensure we can take rapid action to protect other children and staff in nursery.
- **Baby Unit:** Please bring your child to the front door. A staff member will meet you at the door and sign your child in.
- **Over Twos:** Please bring your child to the back-garden gate (weather permitting). A staff member will meet you at the gate and sign your child in.
- Please collect your child from the lobby at the end of the day.
- Please apply sun cream to your child before bringing them to nursery each day. Staff will apply further nursery sun cream throughout the day as required.
- Please keep us up-to-date via email of any changes to your child's dietary requirements, allergies, care needs, medical conditions etc.
