Our Doctor's Surgery



We have been writing prescriptions, measuring medicine, looking at x-rays, putting on bandages and talking about keeping healthy and safe in our Doctor's Surgery! Some children have recently visited the hospital so this encouraged them share their own experiences.

EYFS- Expressive Arts & Design, 30-50 months: Engages in imaginative role-play based on own first-hand experiences.

Literacy, 40-60 months: Gives meaning to marks they make as they draw, write and paint.

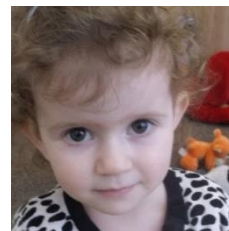
