September 2015: What are we learning at Blue Bell Woods?

Transport and Road Safety

We have been learning about transport; we have designed and made our own car models, made free drawings of different vehicles, selected and used transport stencils, made tracks in paint with toy cars, and selected resources to made junk modelling binoculars to look for aeroplanes! This interest has led onto learning about keeping safe by the road, following a parent's request to teach the children about road safety.

Development ~ 30-50 months: Uses onehanded tools and equipment, e.g. makes
snips in paper with child scissors.
Expressive arts and design ~ 30-50
months: Uses various construction
materials. 40-60 months: Manipulates
materials to achieve a planned effect.













Links to the EYFS- Physical
Development 22-36 months:
Beginning to use three fingers (tripod grip) to hold writing tools.
Literacy 40-60 months: Gives meaning to marks they make as they draw, write and paint

Imaginative Role Play!

In the Baby Unit, we have enjoyed caring for the dolls! We have been learning about treating others kindly and gently. Through play, we have learnt about our own and others' care needs; we have changed the dolls' nappies, fed them, rocked them to sleep, took them for walks in the buggies, sang songs to them and identified parts of the body!







Links to the EYFS- Personal, Social and Emotional Development 16-26 months:
Gradually able to engage in pretend play with toys (supports child to understand their own thinking may be different from others).
Physical Development 16-26 months: Shows a desire to help with dressing/undressing and hygiene routines.

Expressive Arts and Design 16-26 months: Pretends that one object represents another, especially when objects have characteristics in common.

We will be organising festive events such as a Christmas Party and Family Sing-a-long nearer the time. We will keep you posted!


