Let's Get Creative! Chalking in the garden



Physical Development- Makes connections between their movement and the marks they make. (EYFS 16-26 months)

Young Ramblers: Exploring our Community



Understanding the World ~ Notices detailed features of objects in their environment. (EYFS 22-36 months)

Book Worms: Sharing Books



Literacy: Shows interest in illustrations and print in books and print in the environment. (EYFS 30-50 months)

Messy Play in the Sand



Physical Development: Shows control in holding and using jugs to pour, hammers, books and mark-making tools. (EYFS 22-36 months)

Health News:
