

Supporting the transition back to nursery

To help us with a safe return to nursery this month, we ask you to:-

- NOT bring your child to nursery, if your child, or someone in your household has coronavirus symptoms.
 - NOT bring your child to nursery if you have been contacted by the NHS track and trace service and your child has been told to self-isolate for 14 days.
 - Be available to collect your child immediately if they develop coronavirus symptoms while at nursery.
 - [Request a test](#) for your child if they display symptoms of coronavirus and notify us immediately of a positive test. A positive test will ensure we can take rapid action to protect other children and staff in nursery.
 - Provide reassurance to your child and offer age-appropriate information. Very young children need simple explanations, such as, 'Some people have been getting poorly. Nursery are being extra careful so we can stay healthy.' Every child is different and it is important to tailor your conversation to your child's developmental level and needs to prepare them for changed routines.
 - Please drop off your child at the BACK GATE – as the weather forecast is fine next week, we hope that coming straight into the garden will ease the transition back into nursery.
 - Please collect your child from the lobby at the end of the day.
 - Please keep us up-to-date via email of any changes to your child's dietary requirements, allergies, care needs, medical conditions etc.

Even if your child is not returning to nursery this month, we are still here to support you as much as possible, so please do [email the nursery](#) if you require any help or advice and we will be in touch.


