### Supporting a love of reading at home...

- ✓ Ask your child to choose what they'd like to read. They'll feel more interested in the story if they've picked it out themselves. (And don't worry if they keep returning to the same story, either!)
- ✓ If you can, turn off the TV, radio and computer. It's easier for both of you to enjoy the story without any other distractions.
- ✓ Sit close together. You could encourage your child to hold the book themselves and turn the pages, too.
- ✓ Borrow a book or story sack from our nursery library. We have a selection of resources in the lobby for families to use—please ask a member of staff when you drop off / collect your child.
- ✓ Join your local library. Libraries are full of great advice and recommendations, and you'll have a new supply of books to enjoy.
