Dates for your diary:

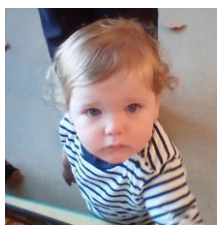
- **Bank holiday – Monday 6th May** the nursery will be closed.

Nursery updates:

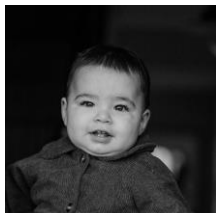

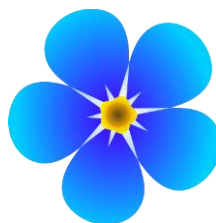

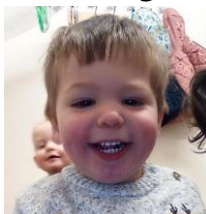

We had a lovely time learning about St George's Day last month. We looked at the English flag and images of knights, dragons, shields and castles. We explored red and white sensory trays and much more!

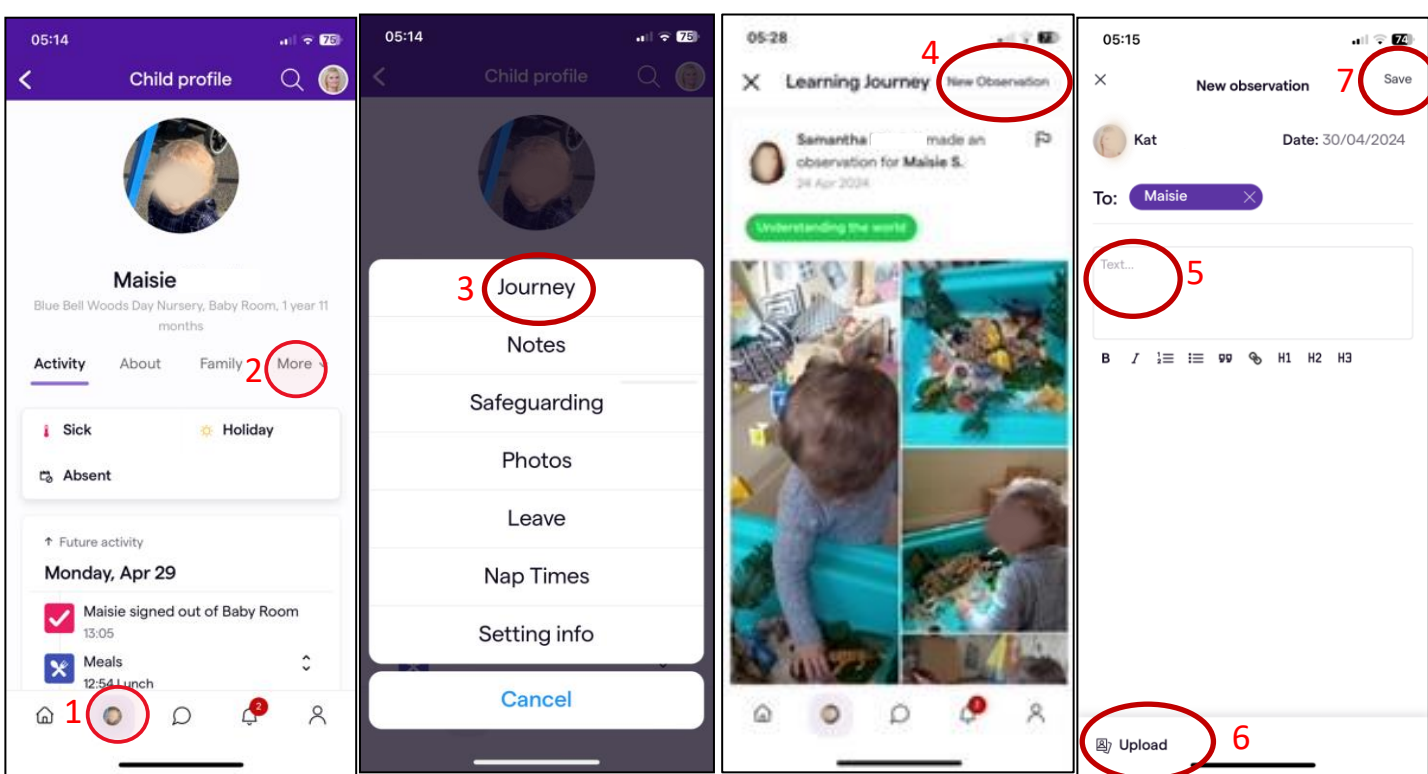


Your FAMILY App - the JOURNEY Tab
