Friday 15th November- NURSERY PHOTOGRAPHER- information will be uploaded to the FAMLY app closer to the time.

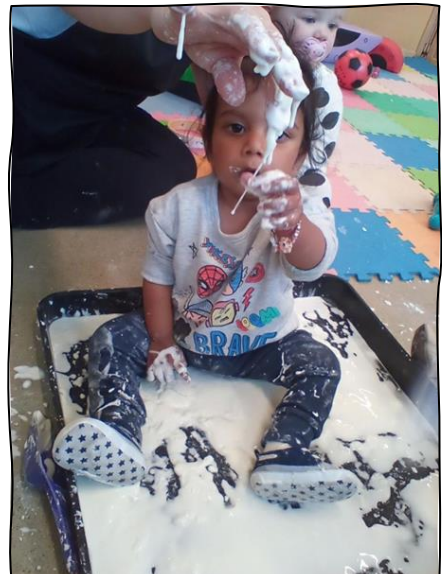
National Teddy Bear Day!

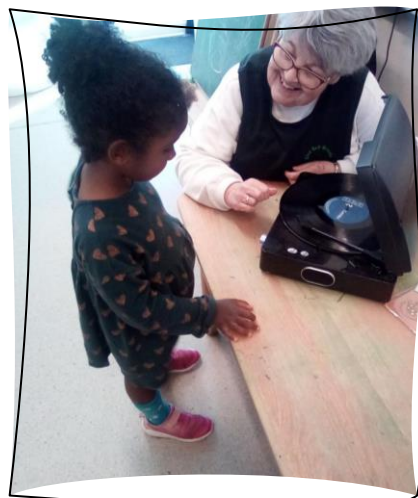
Daffodils
